replaced directly with an International Ballast Water Management Certificate, without survey, with the expiry date being no later than that on the existing Statement of Compliance.

- 2.6. In accordance with IMO Resolution A.1088(28), the vessel is not required to comply with regulation D-2 until the first renewal survey of it's International Oil Pollution Prevention Certificate (IOPP), following the date of entry into force of the BWM Convention on 8 September 2017.
- 2.6.1. This Administration notes that neither the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships, 1973, as modified by the Protocol of 1978 (MARPOL Convention), nor the Survey Guidelines under the Harmonized System of Survey and Certification (HSSC) prevent renewal inspections in advance.
- 2.6.2. Bearing the above in mind, this Administration may authorize, on a case by case basis, the deharmonization of the IOPP Certificate until the date of entry into force of the International Convention for the Control and Management of Ships' Ballast Water and Sediments, 2004. For the purpose of this Circular, "case-by-case" means that authorizations may be granted on ship owner's/manager's request, provided a copy of IOPP certificate is attached with the request letter.
- 2.6.3 Advance renewal inspection of the International Oil Pollution Prevention Certificate can be conducted afloat provided that all the applicable requirements of the renewal survey are complied with.
- 2.6.4 When the renewal survey is completed more than 3 months before the expiry date of the existing certificate, the new certificate shall be valid from the date of completion of the renewal survey to a date not exceeding 5 years from the date of completion of the renewal survey.
- 2.7 This administration also authorizes Recognised Organisations, which classes the Bangladesh flag ships, to carry out approval of Ballast water Management plans & Ballast water treatment plant installation plan approval where necessary.
